New Boarding Prices go into effect on Wednesday, October 18, 2006. Our new price still includes all the value you have come to depend on... a day filled with romping around inside and/or outside, lots of love and attention, and of course, you still get to bring your dog's own food, bed, treats and toys! Policies regarding drop off times and pick up times will remain the same. If you pick up your dog before noon on their departure day, you will not be charged for that day. Our new Boarding Rate is as follows:

Boarding: \$30 per day

- 🐾 Multiple dogs staying in the same room receive a \$5 discount per day per dog
- 🐾 Dogs picked up before noon on the departure date will not be charged for that day.
- 🐾 Dogs picked up after noon will be charged an additional \$20 for the departure day (rather than an additional \$30.)

If you know you will be away over any of the upcoming holidays and have not yet made your reservation for boarding, please do so ASAP! We are anticipating filling up fast!

Special Holiday Hours for Thanksgiving!

Good Dog!

If you haven't taken one of the courses offered by Good Dog! Training, Janice highly recommends it! November Health Tip

At Doggy Daycare and Spa, we recommend feeding your dog a high quality kibble style food. Always check the ingredients of your dog's food, just as you would your own. Many dog foods contain fillers that your dog doesn't need and may actually cause allergic reactions. Some of these fillers include animal by-products (ewww!), corn, white rice, wheat, cellulose (sawdust) and other items you really don't want to know about. You will find that feeding your dog a higher quality food without inferior quality additives will improve the appearance of your dog's coat and skin, may help with stomach disorders, hot spots, itchy paws and ear and eye secretions, as well as create less "brown spots" on your lawn and less "#2 waste." All in all, you will see that the overall health of your dog improves. Some of the foods that Doggy Daycare and Spa recommends include Wellness Brand, Innova and California Natural. All are available at Soldan's. We also recommend feeding your dog meals rather than "free feeding." This allows you to control your dog's weight by monitoring the quantity of food they are eating. In addition, you will know if your dog is not feeling well because he or she will turn down their breakfast or dinner.

 If your dog is showing any signs of illness (vomiting, lethargy, unusual behaviors), please keep him or her home from daycare. We want to keep all our “students” healthy!
